SNOW PHARMA PLANT

Snow Pharma's plant is built at 56,000 square meters of land with a covered area of 30,000 square meters of the manufacturing facility and is located in the "Snow Industrial Park" of 2nd Aino Maina, Kandahar, Afghanistan. In the mentioned Industrial Park, 13 other industries, producing food and medicines, are also planning to launch their projects shortly. The facility when completed will be the first advanced pharmaceutical manufacturing facility in Afghanistan.

Snow Pharma's facility will be developed in three phases. Its first phase, which has already started production of Tablets, Capsules, liquids, Dry Syrups & Sachets. Its second phase (Cepha, Beta, Injectable, Ointments and Cosmetics) will start production later 2025 and its third phase will produce Sterile Drops , Softgels and IV fluids with international GLP, WHO-GMP and ISO standards.

Pharmaceutical Industry in Afghanistan: A Brief Overview

Afghanistan's pharmaceutical sector has faced significant challenges due to decades of civil unrest, resulting in a fragile healthcare system with limited access to quality medicines. Approximately 90% of the population has expressed dissatisfaction with imported medicines, highlighting the urgent need for domestic pharmaceutical production.

In response, initiatives like Snow Pharma are crucial in addressing these challenges by establishing local manufacturing capabilities. The government, through the National Medicine and Health Products Regulatory Authority (NMHRA) established in 2016, is working towards strengthening medicine regulation practices and quality.

Despite these efforts, local pharmaceutical companies currently supply only about 10% of the domestic medicine demand, with the remaining 90% met through imports. Challenges such as shortages of raw materials and drug smuggling hinder the growth of the domestic pharmaceutical industry.

By focusing on local production, quality assurance, and workforce development, Snow Pharma aims to play a pivotal role in transforming Afghanistan's pharmaceutical landscape, ensuring that safe, effective, and affordable medicines are accessible to all.

Snow Pharma aims to be approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to export medicines over the world.



MACHINERY

Snow Pharma has purchased standard, modern, and high-level machinery to produce high quality medicine from European and Indian Companies. A qualified and professional team of foreign engineers will be recruited for operating and maintaining the machinery.

Meanwhile, the professional team of foreign engineers are training young Afghans in operation and maintenance. Gradually, the Afghan engineers will take over the operation and maintenance order.



PRODUCTION

Snow Pharma is fully committed to manufacturing pharmaceutical products which will be sold by its high quality, low price, nationwide and internationally.

Snow Pharma will produce various kinds of medicines including tablets, capsules, liquids, injectable, creams, ointments, drops, cosmetics, IV Infusions, and tropical in the best quality, lower price, and accessible all over Afghanistan. Currently Snow Pharma produces 160 different products and sooner it will be over 200. The mentioned pharmaceutical products are manufactured based on GLP, WHO-CGMP, ISO and AFDA standards. Snow Pharma is equipped with state of art QC lab which ensures the quality and durability of the products.



ANNUAL PRODUCTION CAPACITY

We have kept provision in the same facility to increase the capacity to three times of current production.

HUMAN RESOURCE

Currently, schools and universities in Afghanistan graduate thousands of students each year. Many of these graduates complete their Master's and Doctoral degrees in Europe, the USA, and Asian countries, where they gain proficiency in new technologies and develop modern skills. This pool of talent will serve as a valuable asset for us as we recruit from these highly skilled individuals.

Snow Pharma is playing a significant role in terms of providing working opportunities for young Afghans. Furthermore, Snow Pharma is recruiting an approximately 800 young Afghans for





operating the industry, which is equivalent to supporting approximately (5,600) family members. In the beginning, a professional team of 25 foreign engineers is recruited for operating and maintaining the machinery in different departments (Quality Assurance, Quality Control, Engineering and Production). Meanwhile, the team will also train young Afghans in operation and maintenance. Gradually, the local Afghans will take over the operation and maintenance order.
